If more nominations are received than are required to fill the vacancy, prospective candidates will be given the opportunity of providing me with a brief election address which I will arrange to have circulated with the ballot papers.

Any parent or carer who wishes to stand for election should return the nomination form attached, duly completed, not later than Friday 6th December.

N.B It is a legal requirement that Governors are checked to ensure they are not disqualified from working with children by section 35 of the Criminal Justice and Court Services Act 2000, or because they contravene one of the disqualification conditions imposed in the school governance regulations. For the successful candidate this will entail providing proof of identity and the completion of a declaration form to enable the necessary checks to be carried out.
