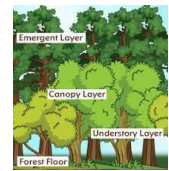




Rainforests

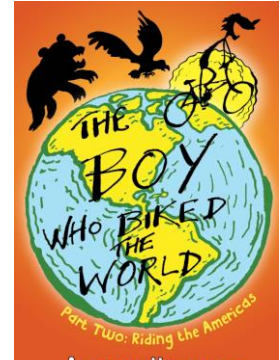


English
