

Home School Agreement

for school during the Covid-19 pandemic

The school will:

- Remind staff to comply with social distancing quidance inside and outside of school.
- Stay alert for any children or staff demonstrating symptoms of the virus and send them home.
- Organise students and staff into working 'bubbles'.
- Ensure tables and work areas in 'bubble' areas are as socially spaced as possible.
- Remind staff and students to come to school in clean clothing.
- Stagger arrival and collection times and points to enable students and adults to socially distance.
- Organise the premises and student movement in a way that reduces contact with other students, e.g. having designated 'bubble' areas, toilets and playgrounds.
- Provide students with their own personal equipment/ small group equipment for use only by them.
- Provide cleaning equipment for teachers' and teaching assistants' use in all 'bubble' areas.
- Follow cleaning routines to keep the premises clean throughout the day.
- Provide soap and sanitiser and hand gel for use by children throughout the school.
- Teach and reinforce safe hand hygiene and respiratory hygiene at all times.
- Ensure shared resources and toys are cleaned at least once a day.
- Regularly review risk assessments, taking account the changing situation relating to the coronavirus and subsequent emerging government guidance.
- Inform parents of any new changes in quidance for schools.
- Discuss the 'children will...' section when pupils come to school and as needed.
- Do our best to make sure activities are fun and active whilst complying with social distancing (where possible).

Parents will:

- Comply with government guidance on social distancing for themselves and their children outside of school in order to minimize the risk to the health and wellbeing of other children and staff.
- Not bring their child into school if they have any coronavirus symptoms, or are unwell in any way.
- Inform the school in advance if they are not bringing their child to school.
- Ensure the school has up-to-date emergency contact numbers for their child.
- ullet Make contact with the school either through phone, email or Class Dojo not expect face-to-face meetings.
- Arrive at, drop off and collect their children from school at the times allocated to them.
- Leave site promptly, not stopping to chat to other parents.
- Use the one-way system in operation for drop off and pick up times.
- Ensure their child only brings a coat, packed lunch, water bottle, hat and sun cream (to

remain in school if needed) to school.

- Ensure their child comes to school in clean uniform every day.
- Practice hand hygiene rules at home.
- Discuss the 'children will...' section below with their child before they come to school.
- Arrange for a Covid 19 test if they or their child starts displaying any symptoms and inform school of this and the outcome immediately.

Children will:

- Stay away from other children as much as possible.
- Try not to touch other people.
- Not touch other people's things.
- Only bring their packed lunch and water bottle to school (hat and sun cream if needed)
- Wash their hands when they arrive at school, before and after they eat, after they have been to the toilet and whenever the adult tells them to.
- Wash their hands carefully with soap for 20 seconds (the length of song to sing as agreed by the class).
- Cough or sneeze into their arm.

Thank you for your continued support.

- Only play with the toys they are told they can.
- Only use their own equipment for their table and learning area.
- Stay where the teacher tells them to in the school building and playground.
