

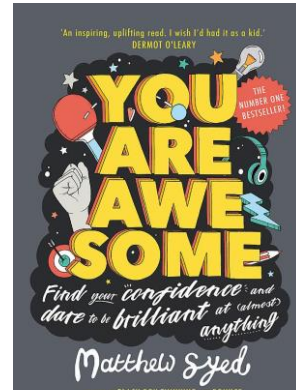
Coal Mining in the North East
