

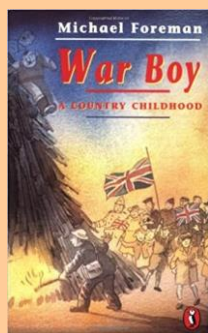


# Land Use
