<u>School Dinners</u> - A reminder that school lunches must be ordered on ParentPay by midnight on Thursday for the following week. This is to help us when ordering the food into school. Any child who has not ordered their meals in advance, will be given the **main hot food** option each day for the following week.

<u>Holidays in Term Time</u> - It is that time of year again when families are taking holidays. Whilst we do not encourage leave in term time, if you do intend on taking your child away, it is vital you fill in a leave of absence request form. In most circumstances we are advised to not authorise any requests but the requested dates are marked onto our registers and school then knows where your child is. It is best to be truthful because the children often talk about an impending holiday or speak about their holidays on their return.

<u>One-way System</u> - Please continue to use our one-way system. Although Covid procedures are no longer in place, we have found for health and safety and safeguarding that the one-way system is helpful. If you are running late, please use the main office rather than cheating and going the opposite way to the one-way system.

<u>Sun Lotion, Hats and Water Bottles</u> - On days when it is forecast to be particularly sunny, please ensure children come to school wearing sun lotion. Children are welcome to bring a named bottle of sun lotion into school to reapply at lunchtime. A hat and water bottle are also vital as children will be outside parts of the day.

<u>Local Residents and Parking</u> - We have had a few complaints recently from local residents about parking in the estate who haven't been able to get off their driveways or the roads and paths have been blocked. I understand parking is very limited and hopefully when we have our new school building this can be addressed but, in the meantime, we need to continue to be mindful of not blocking driveways and access when visiting school.
